## Kool Aid® Activity

## Supplies:

- 2 packets of regular Kool Aid (any flavor, use same flavor for each pitcher)
- 2, 2-quart pitchers
- Cold water
- 6 packets of Sweet N Low
- 36 packets of Equal
- Spoon for stirring
- Cups for sampling: color coded

Stir each packet of Kool Aid with water in two separate 2-quart pitchers.

- In one pitcher use 24 packets of aspartame to replace one cup of sugar. Label this sample "A".
- 2. In the other pitcher, use 12 packets of aspartame plus 6 packets of Sweet N Low (or other saccharine based sweetener) to replace the sugar. Label this sample "B".
- 3. Conduct a blind taste test with the participants to see if they can tell that the two sweeteners together produce a sweeter product than the one alone.
- 4. Using color coded cups helps to keep the tasting information in order. Or label the cups "sample A" and "sample B".
- 5. Discuss the differences in sweetness
  - a. ask which one they liked best
  - b. which one tasted sweeter
  - c. reveal your recipe for sweetening

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
